Dear Secretary Bose;

Fishing in our area will be severely restricted with the draining of Kilarc reservoir. Kilarc is presently the only near by location where fish may be taken. All streams in our watershed are anadromous waters with the exception of Clover Creek above a 60 ft (ht?) waterfall. Ninety + percent are on private property or in very rugged terrain.

There are no other lakes in our watershed or near us open to public fishing, the nearest will be Grace lake, a PG&E facility near Shingletown. It is a 20-mile 45minute drive from downtown Whitmore.  
(And not nearly as nice and peaceful as Kilarc.)
